Report To Glemsford Parish Council For PCM 14/05/13

This report covers the period from **01/04/2013** to **13/05/2013**. During this time there has been **10** crimes recorded within the parish, this compares to **5** crimes for the same period last year.

BREAKDOWN OF CRIME

#Vehicle crime

- Between the 07/04/13 and 16/04/13 suspects unknown have damaged a parked car on Egremont Street. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/787 Pc 1543 Jones
- On the night of 26/04/13 a vehicle parked on Lower Road was damaged. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/860 Pc 1424 Shelley
- Between 14/04/13 and 02/05/13 a theft from motor vehicle took place on Skates Hill. SU/13/895 Pc 704 Horton
- On 12/05/13 damage was caused to a vehicle parked in Egremont street. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/956 Ps 566 Horton

#Assaults and public order

- On 08/04/13 and assault ABH took place in Highbank. Arrests were made and person has been charged. SU/13/723 Pc 1635 Moore

#Theft

- Between 08/04/13 and 10/04/13 suspects unknown have stolen a bank card. Location of theft is unknown however logged as Glemsford due to victim's home address. SU/13/804 Pc 1796 Walsh

#Criminal Damage

- On the night of 06/04/13 suspects unknown have damaged a property in Kings Road. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/725 Pc 1655 Rout
- On 13/04/13 fencing to a property in Cavendish Lane was cut by suspects unknown. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/757 Pc 566 Horton
- On the evening of 21/04/13 damage was caused to a property on Brices Way. This investigation is on-going. SU/13/827_Pc 1424 Shelley
- On the evening of 30/04/13 damage was caused to the play park in Schoolfield. This investigation is on going. SU/13/887 Pc 1142 Bala
