### BREAKDOWN OF CRIME

#### **#Burglary Other Building**

Overnight on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October unknown offenders have forced open a large warehouse in Low Street and stolen red diesel. No forensics, witnesses, suspects or CCTV.
