Report To Glemsford Parish Council For PCM 12/03/13

This report covers the period from **12/02/2013** to **12/03/2013**. During this time there has been **6** crimes recorded within the parish, this compares to **6** crimes for the same period last year.

BREAKDOWN OF CRIME

#Burglary Other Building

- An attempt burglary other building took place to a shed on Angel Lane. The attempt took place between 1800 and 1845 on 05/03/13. This crime is still being investigated. SU/13/513 Pc 1263 Battershall

#Vehicle crime

- On the night of 18/02/13 a theft from motor vehicle took place on Hunts Hill. The catalytic convertor was stolen. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/448 Pc 1293 Johnson

#Assaults and public order

- On 13/02/13 following a dispute a male was arrested for assault on Tye Green. This male was cautioned. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/328 Pc 1263 Battershall

#Other

- On 16/02/13 at 0300 a male was arrested for driving a motor vehicle with excess alcohol and possession of an article with a blade on the A1092. The male was charged for both offences. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/352 and SU/13/353 Pc 1263 Battershall
- On the 28/02/13 following a search a male was arrested and currently on bail from producing controlled drug. No further information is available. SU/13/472 Pc 1549 Steel

Crimes recorded within the Parish of Glemsford the last 4 weeks have not increased from the same period last year. Out of six of the crimes, four have had arrests. It is reassuring to see that no burglary dwellings have taken place although Police urge residents to not become complacent with their home security. Crime across Suffolk is reducing, however please be assured that Suffolk Police are continuing to target those individuals who are involved in burglary within our communities.

A Police crime reduction surgery was held today at the village hall and proved again to be successful with visitors.
