### Report To Glemsford Parish Council For PCM 14/02/2012

During this time there has been **6** crimes recorded within the parish, this compares to **10** crimes for the same period last year.

### BREAKDOWN OF CRIME

#### Vehicle crime

- Between the times of 1430 – 1800 on 25/01/12 a theft from motor vehicle took place on Lion Road where by £2141 worth of goods were stolen. SU/12/221 PCSO Partington
